Technology transfer entries and patents must be submitted with an attached contract and patent certification, respectively. For entries in which authors have an equal contribution, a soft copy of the part of the paper that marks the contribution of each author must be attached. Applicants whose selection periods for their research results are extended due to giving birth, taking parental leave, or being registered to compulsory military service within the past five years must attach documented proof. Please scan the aforementioned proof documents and attach it after this form before uploading. Entries with incomplete provision of required proof documents will not receive points.

★Note 2. Entries in this form that are verified to be incorrect will be corrected. Entries that cannot be verified will not receive points.

## Form-Filling Instructions

### 1. Precautions before filling out the form

Please refer to the following descriptions for filling out Forms A and B and attach the required proof documents after the forms. Convert the completed forms and documents into PDF format before uploading.

### 2. Number of representative research results in the research experience section of Form E

(1) I. Applicants with more than 5 years of research experience should provide up to 7 of their most representative research results from the past 5 years and complete Form E to calculate their research performance index. Applicants with 4, 3, and less than 3 years of research experience should provide at most 4, 2, and 1, respectively, of their most representative research results from the past 5 years and complete Form E to calculate their research performance index.

II. Applicants who have given birth or taken parental leave within the past five years may select research results obtained within the past seven years. The applicants’ research seniority should be deducted by two years, according to which they select the corresponding research seniority from the four choices provided in the table. Additionally, applicants shall attach documented proof of birth or parental leave.

III. Applicants who were registered to the compulsory military service within the past five years may select the research results from the past five years, plus their number of years served. The applicants’ research seniority should be deducted by the serving period, according to which the applicants select the corresponding research seniority from the four choices provided in the table. Additionally, applicants shall attach documented proof of their compulsory service in the military.

#### (2) Starting time of research experience:

I. The moment of taking on a position as a full-time assistant professor at a domestic or foreign university

II. The moment of taking on a position as a full-time teacher or researcher with a doctorate degree in a domestic or foreign university (not including post-doctoral qualifications)

III. The moment of appointment as a qualified or associate researcher at a domestic or foreign university

IV. After serving for 4 years as a lecturer, tutor, or researcher with a master’s degree at a domestic and foreign university

V. After serving 2 years as an attending physician.

(3) **Multiple years of research experience should be combined.** For example, an individual who obtained a doctorate degree through 4 years of on-the-job training after 4 years as an attending physician or 6 years as a lecturer has 6 years of research experience.

### 4. Filling in the research result name

Applicants shall include the aforementioned types of research results published between **January 1, 2021, to December 31, 2025**. Points will not be granted for falsified or unverifiable entries. If the entry is a forthcoming publication, applicants must attach documented proof of the paper’s acceptance. Points will not be granted for forthcoming publications with no documented proof.

(1) **Writing the names of full articles, presentation articles, case reports, or review article papers:**

1. Include the names of all authors (in the original order) as well as the paper title, published journal name, published year, published journal issue, and the starting and ending page numbers.
2. Underline the name of the applicant (principal investigator) and journal title.
3. Mark the corresponding author names with a “\*” sign.
4. Include the full journal title or the journal’s abbreviation in accordance with the Journal Citation Reports.
5. Journals published in SSCI or EI should include (SSCI) or (EI) after the article title, respectively.

**(2) Writing the patent and technology transfer documents:**

1. Patent entries must include the patent name, inventor, certification number, patent nationality, and patent term.
2. Technology transfer entries must include the technology name, technology transfer price, the transferee, and date of transfer.
3. Foreign patents or technology transfers should include the Chinese names of patents or technology transfers.
4. Please reference Table 6(2) for filling out the (C), (J), and (A) weighted points.

**6. Research result scoring**

- (1) Scoring of academic journal papers:** After filling out the weighted points according to paper type, journal rank, and author rank, the journal publication points are obtained by multiplying the three weighted points (C×J×A).

### IV. Equal Contribution: Entries with authors of equal contribution should include a hard copy of the paper that marks the contribution of each author.

- For two to three authors with the same level of contribution, the authors are ranked according to their weighted points.
- For four to six authors with the same level of contribution, the authors are ranked based on 60% of their weighted points.
- For seven or more authors with the same level of contribution, the authors are ranked based on 20% of their weighted points.
- Authors with equal contribution ranked equally. The ranking of the author of the following contribution shall receive weighted authorship points according to their author rank. Points less than 0.5 are rounded up to 0.5.

(A) Contribution rate: Weighted points of all coinventors of a patent are calculated according to their contribution rate. For example, a contribution rate of 50% results in a weighted point of 0.5.

Note 1: Only documents with TMU as the patentee or indicating TMU as the copatentee, such as contracts of industry–academia collaboration and technology transfer contracts, are counted.

Note 2: A patent that has been granted in multiple countries (or regions) or one that is divided into more than one patent in accordance with national requirements shall be treated as a single patent; the patent with the highest score will be accounted for. For a patent with technology transfer, either the patent or technology transfer, or whichever has the higher technology transfer score, will be accounted for; double counting will not be allowed.

**(J) Patent weighting: Invention patent technology transfer is given a weighted point of 3; noninvention patent technology transfer is given a weighted point of 1.5.**

(A) Contribution rate: Weighted points of all coinventors of a technology transfer case are calculated according to their contribution rate. For example, a contribution rate of 50% results in a weighted point of 0.5.

Note 1: The income generated from technology transfer is calculated based on TMU’s actual income. This actual income refers to the income acquired from research and development achievements stipulated in Article 2, Paragraph 3 of the Guidelines Governing the Attribution, Management, and Utilization of Research and Development Results Obtained by the Taipei Medical University and Its Affiliated Institutions.” The actual income is also determined based on the actual payment wired (or the value of the equity delivered) by the buyers.

Note 2: **An invention patent must be a licensed patent to enable technology transfer.**

Note 3: The technology transfer cost not generated from actual technology transfer, such as the early-stage technology transfer funds, cannot be considered as part of the technology transfer cost items listed above.
